1.	What do the bees use their winter fuel (honey) to produce?
2.	What does the beekeeper use to produce the winter syrup that he feeds to them?
3.	What is the recipe for the winter syrup (ml water per kg)?
4.	Name a substance that the bees add to the syrup to turn it into a form of honey:
5.	How much food (kg) does the colony need to see them safely through winter?
6.	What is the feeder called that has a hole up the middle with an upside-down cup over it?
7.	How does the bee transfer the syrup back down into the hive?
8.	The bees process the syrup to reduce the water content – how much water will be in the processed honey (%) ?
9.	The beekeeper lifts one side of the hive to check how much food the bees have stored. What does he call the lifting action?
